Getting There, Parking & Fee

Great Falls Park is about 30 minutes northwest of Capitol Hill. Parking can be tight, so we encourage carpooling or using a rideshare service.

There is a park entrance fee of \$20 per vehicle, \$15 per motorcycle or \$10 per person (by foot or bicycle)

Cell reception is limited at the park and Wi-Fi is unavailable. If possible, plan your return ride before arriving at the park.
